As in years past, City of Albany residents will have multiple chances to dispose of their household hazardous and electronic waste in an environmentally safe way. Residents must pre-register to participate. Please note: phone registration is closed the Friday before each event and online registration is closed the Tuesday before each event. However, registration for an event could close earlier if the maximum capacity is reached. At no time should hazardous waste or electronics be placed curbside. Successful collection efforts have helped to protect our groundwater from hazardous waste contamination.
